



## SINGAPORE AIRLINES ECONOMY CLASS GV2 FARE CONDITIONS

### 1. VALIDITY:

**Sale:** on/ after 01 April 2012 to on/before 30 September 2012

**Ex-SIN Travel:** on/ after 01 April 2012

### 2. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 2.1 All fares listed are nett in Singapore dollars and exclude all airport taxes, fuel surcharges etc. Note: Documentation fee is not applicable.
- 2.2 All fares listed are valid for round trip journeys originating from Singapore and must be issued in Singapore on Singapore Airlines Electronic Tickets (ET) for travel on Singapore Airlines (SQ) flights only.
- 2.3 All fares listed are not valid for travel on SQ1000 to SQ9999 series. Refer to fare sheets for other flight restrictions, if any.
- 2.4 Customers requiring additional seats for personal comfort, bulky or fragile items etc are not permitted to purchase GV fares for both his/her seat and the extra seat required.
- 2.5 The fare conditions listed here are subject to change.

### 3 TICKETING CONDITIONS

- 3.1 Eligibility: In each PNR there must be 2 or more passengers traveling together throughout the journey and all tickets must be issued in sequence. Additional passengers in a different PNR are not allowed to be TCP to the first PNR. No deviation of any passenger throughout the journey is allowed.
- 3.2 Reservations/ Ticketing:  
Reservations must be confirmed prior to ticketing. Tickets must show confirmed seat reservations.
- 3.3 Seasonality:  
Where applicable, the dates of departure of the first outbound sector will determine the season for the entire journey.
- 3.4 Minimum/ Maximum stay: As stipulated in the fare sheets.
- 3.5 Stopovers: As stipulated in the fare sheets.  
**Exception:**  
Fares to North and South America, stopovers in BCN, FRA, HKG, MOW, SEL and TYO are permitted at a surcharge of SGD200 for each stop.
- 3.6 Transfers: As stipulated in the fare sheets.  
**Exception:**  
Fares to North and South America, transfers in BCN, FRA, HKG, MOW, SEL and TYO are permitted at a surcharge of SGD200 for each transfer.
- 3.7 Blackout Period:  
Where applicable, the blackout period is determined by the outbound travel date.
- 3.8 Permitted combinations:
  - 3.8.1 End-on combination and side trip is not permitted.
  - 3.8.2 Turnaround open jaw journey as stipulated in the fare sheet provided the higher return fares must be charged.
- 3.9 Changes/ Cancellation/ Refund:
  - 3.9.1 Date changes are permitted at USD20 but require re-issuance of e-tickets. The change fee of USD20 is to be indicated in the OB tax code of the reissued e-tickets. All the ticketing conditions must be met, in particular to conditions 2.3. Flight applications and 3.1. Eligibility.
  - 3.9.2 Rebooking and rerouting is permitted within the same fare condition or to the next higher applicable fare with fare difference and rebooking fee of USD20. At any time, fare may be used as credit towards payment of any SQ fare from point of origin provided the conditions of the new fares are met. Residual value from re-issuance is non-refundable.
  - 3.9.3 Refund is not permitted for totally or partially unused ticket.

**Note: All requests for reissue must be submitted on SQ Re-issuance form and faxed to 6258 9827 for approval.**

**No-show:** In all cases of reissue, reroute and refund, proof of cancellation for the confirmed reservations of the original e-tickets must be submitted (through BSP). Otherwise, no-show fees of USD100 will be applicable per sector.

#### 3.10 Child / Infant:

- 3.10.1 Accompanied Child / Accompanied infant occupying a seat: 75% of the applicable GV2 adult fare will apply.
- 3.10.2 Unaccompanied Child / Minor (5 years to under 18years) / Infant not occupying a seat: GV fares are not permitted.

#### 3.11 Endorsement box to reflect as:

'VALID SQ ONLY. GV2 COND **APPLY.NO** RFND/FFP.QS - -'. If fare is not applicable to a specific flight number, please also indicate: 'Not Valid on SQyyy / zzz' where "yyy" and "zzz" are the flight numbers that are not applicable.  
E.g 'Valid SQ only. GV2. Not Valid SQ972. No Refund/FFP. QS - -'.
